The purpose of this circular is to inform members that effective September 14, 2022, emergency rulemaking <u>repealed</u> <u>24 DCMR § 2343.1 (Ammunition Carried by Licensee)</u>, which limited the amount of ammunition concealed-carry licensees could carry to 20 rounds.

Accordingly, there is no longer any limit on the amount of ammunition concealed-carry licensees may carry.

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: It is still illegal for persons in the District to possess large capacity ammunition feeding devices capable of accepting more than 10 rounds of ammunition, per DC Official Code 7-2506.01(b).

These rules are currently in effect until January 12, 2023, but are expected to be made permanent upon publication of final rulemaking in the *DC Register*. Members will be notified in the event that the final rulemaking does not move forward. While this circular will expire on September 16, 2024, changes made to the DCMR as described in this circular will be permanent until such time as they are amended.
