I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this executive order is to amend the policy regarding service pistols for members placed on sick leave or limited duty by the Medical Services Division (MSD) for more than 15 calendar days.

II. REGULATIONS

- A. Members placed on sick leave or limited duty for more than 15 calendar days shall:
1. Have their police powers revoked and surrender their service pistol and, as applicable, their electronic control device (ECD) and M4 rifle to the revoking official.
 2. Not be eligible to file a request to retain their weapons.
- B. No later than the 60th calendar day of sick leave or limited duty, the member's weapons shall be transferred to the Metropolitan Police Department Armorer.
- C. To the extent the provisions of this executive order are in conflict with orders previously issued, the provisions in this executive order shall prevail. Specifically, this order rescinds:
1. GO-PER-100.11 (Medical Services), Part V.J.2-4.
 2. GO-OMA-120.24 (Revocation/Restoration of Police Powers), the NOTE under Part V.A.6.
 3. GO-RAR-901.01 (Handling of Service Weapons), Part V.D.14.a.(1)-(5).
