I. PURPOSE

Due to the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) emergency, the Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) and the Office of Unified Communications (OUC) are modifying the criteria and expanding the types of reports that can be taken by the OUC's Telephone Reporting Unit (TRU). The purpose of this order is to outline the criteria changes and the additional incidents that will be eligible for telephone reporting during the COVID-2019 emergency.

II. PROCEDURES

- A. Members at the scene of an incident and members at police facilities shall continue to complete police reports and **shall not** refer complainants to the TRU.
- B. For an incident to qualify for a TRU report, the incident <u>must not</u> be a violent crime, involve an intrafamily incident or offense, involve a weapon, or involve serious injuries. TRU reports shall also <u>not</u> be used when a suspect is on the scene or in the immediate vicinity at the time of the initial 911 call. If circumstances warrant police response during the initial call interview, the OUC will dispatch members to the scene.
- C. Subject to meeting the criteria outlined in Part II.B, the following incidents are eligible for TRU reports:

10.	Lost Property/Lost Tags
11.	Miscellaneous/Additional Information - NEW
12.	Shoplifting - NEW
13.	Sick/Injured Person - NEW

14. Simple Assault - NEW
15. Stolen Autos
16. Stolen Bicycles
17. Stolen Tags
18. Taking Property without Right - NEW
19. Theft 1
20. Theft 2
21. Theft from Auto (1 or 2)
22. Threats to do Bodily Harm/Misdemeanor Threats- NEW

III. PROVISION

To the extent the procedures in this executive order conflict with procedures previously issued, the procedures in this executive order shall prevail.
