

EXECUTIVE ORDER

Subject: Regular or Continuous Associations and Involvements

Related to GO-PER-201.26 (Duties, Responsibilities, and Conduct of Members of the Department)

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this executive order is to amend Part V.A.4 of GO-PER-201.26 (Duties, Responsibilities, and Conduct of Members of the Department). To the extent that provisions in this executive order conflict with existing directives, the provisions set forth in this executive order shall prevail.

II. PROCEDURES

- A. Members shall avoid regular or continuous associations or dealings at places that they know are places under criminal investigation, or that they know have a reputation in the community or the department for felonious activity, except as necessary in the performance of official duties or where unavoidable because of immediate familial relationships.
- B. Members shall not commence personal relationships with people who they know have been convicted, or arrested multiple times within the previous five years, for a crime of violence as defined in [DC Official Code § 23-1331\(4\)](#) or a dangerous crime as defined in [DC Official Code § 23-1331\(3\)](#).
