

EXECUTIVE ORDER

Subject: Coronavirus 2019: Illness and Exposure Protocols
Number EO-23-002

Related to: GO-PER-100.11 (Medical Services)

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this executive order is to provide updated information to Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) members regarding positive COVID-19 test results and exposure to COVID-19. District of Columbia Department of Health (DOH) COVID-19 guidance is available for review at <https://coronavirus.dc.gov/>. To the extent the provisions in this executive order conflict with directives previously issued, the provisions of this executive order shall prevail.

II. PROCEDURES

A. Illness

1. Members experiencing symptoms consistent with COVID-19 or the flu are reminded to stay home, notify their supervisor, and notify the Medical Services Division (MSD) (sworn) at 202-854-7731 or Human Resources Management Division (HRMD) (civilian) at 202-727-4261. Members shall be placed on sick leave, may be directed by MSD or HRMD to take a test, and shall not return to the workplace until receiving MSD or HRMD authorization.
2. Members who test positive for COVID-19 may only return to the workplace after being cleared by the Police and Fire Clinic (sworn) or HRMD (civilian). PFC or HRMD, as appropriate, shall ensure members have medical clearance from a doctor or can otherwise demonstrate recovery from COVID-19 prior to authorizing their return to work.

B. Exposure

Members who have a confirmed COVID-19 exposure shall notify MSD (sworn) or HRMD (civilian) for instructions based on CDC and DOH guidance.
