The purpose of this executive order is to provide procedures in support of Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration (ABCA) regulatory enforcement measures.

1. Reports

Members completing records management system (RMS) reports related to ABCA-licensed businesses shall add the incident type "ABC Violation or Incident" to ensure that these reports can be identified within RMS.

2. Regulatory Support

- a. ABCA will request on-scene support from MPD during their inspections of ABCA-licensed establishments to ensure the safety of all involved parties.
- b. Upon notification of an inspection in their district, commanding officials shall assign uniformed members to assist. Assigned members shall request Violent Crime Suppression Division (VCSD) response if on-scene responsibilities exceed the scope of Patrol Services.
- c. ABCA is responsible for collecting and storing seized cannabis (and any other property or evidence related to their investigations).
