I. BACKGROUND

The purpose of this order is to specify the types of incidents that members must transmit to the Command Information Center (CIC) on the City-Wide 1 Radio Zone.

II. REGULATIONS

- A. After the scene is rendered safe and any relevant lookout is broadcast over the Patrol District channel, the first member on the scene shall transmit preliminary information to the CIC on the City-Wide 1 Radio Zone concerning the following types of events:
1. Robberies;
 2. Shootings;
 3. Stabbings; and
 4. Critical missing persons where a command post has been established.
- B. The member shall include the following information in his/her transmission to the CIC:
1. Location;
 2. Preliminary description of offense or incident;
 3. Lookout information;
 4. Traffic closures; and
 5. Other pertinent facts.

- C. When the first responding member is delayed in transmitting the information, the Watch Commander is responsible for ensuring the information is transmitted.
