Members shall make the following changes to General Order 201.15 (Retirement Program).

PART IA1b is amended as follows:

Delete "Director, Field Inspections Division" and insert in lieu thereof "Director, Labor Relations Division."

PART IC is amended as follows:

"C. Revocation of Police Powers of Members Appearing Before the Retirement Board.

1. Whenever a member is placed in the sick leave category and is awaiting a hearing before the Retirement Board, the member's police powers shall be revoked in accordance with the procedures outlined in General Order 1202.4.
2. If the member's physical condition precludes his/her reporting to the organizational element for the revocation procedure, arrangements shall be made by the commanding officer to have the member's police powers revoked at another location.
3. Such member shall appear before the Board for a hearing in civilian clothes.
4. Upon receiving notification that retirement has been denied and the member will be restored to a duty status, the affected member shall, within 24 hours of receipt of the notification, report to his/her assigned organizational element where his/her police powers shall be restored or a supplemental PD 77 will be served upon the member to reflect the change in duty status. If the member is restored to full police duties, he/she shall be directed by his/her supervisory official to report to the Property Division to obtain all items of equipment surrendered at the time of revocation.
5. If the member's retirement is denied and he/she is not restored to full police duties, the member's police powers shall remain revoked until such time as he/she is restored to full duty or his/her retirement is approved by the Retirement Board."

PART IIA2 & 3 is amended as follows:

"2. Pre-Hearing Responsibilities.

It shall be the responsibility of the commanding officer of a member of the department who is on sick leave and awaiting a hearing before the Retirement Board to take the following action prior to the member's appearance before the Board for a hearing:

- a. Revoke the police powers of the affected member in accordance with the provisions of General Order 1202.4,
- b. Arrange for all items of equipment surrendered to be delivered to the Director, Property Division and
- c. Advise the member that he/she is prohibited from carrying an off-duty revolver while in a revoked status.

3. Post-Hearing Responsibilities.

Upon completion of the hearing by the Retirement Board, the member's commanding officer shall take one of the following actions:

- a. In the event the member is retired, the commanding officer shall obtain all items of uniform and equipment from the retired member and transfer custody of the property to the Director, Property Division.
- b. In the event the member is not retired and he/she is returned to full police duty, the commanding officer shall instruct the member to report to the Property Division to obtain all items of equipment surrendered at the time of revocation.
- c. In the event the member is not retired and he/she remains on sick leave or is placed in another duty and pay status (i.e., limited duty) as specified by the Board of Surgeons, the member's police powers shall remain revoked and a supplemental PD Form 77 (Revocation of Police Powers and Notice of Duty and Pay Status) shall be prepared, as appropriate."

*This special order shall remain in effect until its provisions are incorporated into General Order 201.15.
