The purpose of this Special Order is to inform members of the Continuing Appropriations Bill for Fiscal Year 1987 (H.J. Res. 738) signed by the President on October 18, 1986, and which contains an amendment to Chapter 3, Title 3, U.S. Code, Section 202.

This amendment consolidates protective measures around the White House by adding the Treasury Building Annex and grounds, which is located on the southwest corner of Pennsylvania Avenue and Madison Place N.W., to those areas secured by the U.S. Secret Service Uniformed Division. This action is intended to allow the Secret Service Uniformed Division to serve a dual purpose which is to provide security functions for the Department of the Treasury, and to create a security buffer on the east side of the White House corresponding to that provided by the West Executive Avenue and the Old Executive Office Building on the west side.

\*This Special Order shall remain in effect until its contents are incorporated into General Order 310.3 (U.S. Secret Service Uniformed Division).
